General Requirements:

Unless otherwise stated, repertoire requirements are three memorized compositions from three contrasting periods. Concerti movements are not allowed for pianists unless specifically required. Repertoire repeated from any previous year is not allowed. Students need to bring original scores to the adjudication with the measures numbered. No photocopies will be accepted. Repertoire change requests will be considered up to 14 days prior to the audition date. String, voice, and concerto students must supply their own accompanists.

Students may enter only one scholarship per year and may not enter the same one again if they received first place in that award in any previous year.

1st, 2nd, and 3rd prizes are available unless a scholarship specifies otherwise. Award amounts vary with cash available in OMTA investment accounts and are subject to change depending on funds available.

All scholarships are now offered annually except those with specific years listed.

PIANO

Gladys Strong OMTA Piano: Open to high school graduates through age 22. Sight reading required in Baroque or Classical literature. (20 minutes allowed for this audition.) Entry fee: \$30.00

Jean Williams: Open to high school students in grades 9 to 12. (20 minutes allowed for this audition.) Entry fee: \$30.00

Requirements:

- a. Three memorized compositions from contrasting periods
- b. Sight reading from the Baroque or Classical periods

D. Suzanne Raines: Open to students between 12 and 15 years of age. Participants are required to play two or three memorized pieces from contrasting periods. (7 to 10 minutes allowed for this audition.) First, second, third awards. Entry fee: \$20.00

Donna and David Eason: Open to high school students in grades 9 through 12. (20 minutes allowed for this audition.) Entry fee: \$30.00 Requirements:

- a. Bach Prelude and Fugue
- b. First movement of a Mozart, Haydn, or Beethoven Sonata
- c. Romantic period applicant's choice
- d. Impressionist or Contemporary period applicant's choice

Eleanor East and Edward G. Michaels: Open to students between 12 and 15 years of age. (10 minutes allowed for this audition.) Entry fee: \$20.00

Lillian Pettibone: Open to high school students in grades 9 to 12. (20 minutes allowed for this audition.) Entry fee: \$30.00 Requirements:

- a. Composition by Scarlatti
- b. Composition by Ravel or Rachmaninoff
- c. One movement of any piano concerto (contestants must provide their own accompanist)
- d. Composition of choice

Aurora Underwood: Open to high school students in grades 9 to 12. (20 minutes allowed for this audition.) Entry fee: \$30.00

Requirements:

- a. Bach Prelude and Fugue
- b. Sonata (complete) from the classical period
- c. Chopin Etude
- d. Impressionist or 20thor 21st century composition

Edith Strange: Open to high school seniors who plan to pursue music in college. (15 minutes allowed for this audition.) Entry fee: \$25.00

Requirements:

- a. Three memorized compositions from contrasting periods
- b. Sight reading

Cris Tapang Memorial: Open to students ages 13 to 15. (15 minutes allowed for this audition.) First, second, third awards. Entry fee: \$25.00 Requirements:

- a. Classical period Sonata movement
- b. One piece from the Romantic period
- c. Composition of choice

Dorothy Pederson Fahlman: Open to high school juniors and seniors who have received a "Successful Evaluation" in either 2 lower division and 3 upper division syllabus examinations or all 4 upper division syllabus examinations. Level X must be completed "With Distinction" and the student must be a junior or senior at the time of the Level X examination. (15 minutes allowed for this audition.) First, second, third awards. Entry fee: \$25.00

Tom O'Brien: (15 minutes allowed for this audition.) Two equal winners, one from each division. Entry fee: \$25.00

- Junior division, ages 11 through 14
- Senior division, ages 15 through 18

Requirements:

- a. First or last movement of a sonata by Haydn, Mozart, or Beethoven
- b. A composition by Chopin, Schumann, or Brahms
- c. A composition in the impressionist or 20th or 21st century periods (including Rachmaninoff)

Francis Virginia Melton: To be awarded annually to high school seniors. Open to Salem students only 2015 and 2017 and to statewide students 2016 and 2018. (10 minutes allowed for this audition.) Entry fee: \$20.00

VOICE

OMTA Voice: Open to students in grades 9 - 12. (10 minutes allowed for this audition.) Entry fee: \$20.00

Derthick Club Voice: One-time award, not an annual scholarship. Open to voice students in grades 9-12. Student must be a resident of Clackamas County. (10 minutes allowed for this audition.) Entry fee: \$20.00

Lina Belle Tartar: Open to voice students ages 17 to 23. (15 minutes allowed for this audition.) Entry fee: \$25.00

Requirements: Student will choose to perform three of the following four options

- a. A song from early English classics or Italian anthology
- b. An aria from an oratorio or an opera in the original language and key
- c. A song in German or French
- d. A song in English by a 20th century American, British, or Canadian composer

MISCELLANEOUS

Derthick Club Instrumental: One-time award, not an annual scholarship. Excludes piano. Open to instrumental students in grades 9–12. Student must be a resident of Clackamas County. (10 minutes allowed for this audition.) Entry fee: \$20.00

Orchestral Instrumental: Excludes piano. (15 minutes allowed for this audition.) Entry fee: \$25.00. Two divisions:

- High school grades 9 12
- High school graduates through age 22

Jeannette Scott Briggs: Open to viola and violin students in grades 1 to 12. (10 minutes allowed for this audition.) One award for each division. Entry fee: \$20.00

- Elementary (grades 1-5)
- Middle School (grades 6 8)
- High School (grades 9 12)

Maude Sardam Collaborative: Open to students ages 15 to 20. (15 minutes allowed for this audition.) One first place award to be divided among the members of the ensemble. Entry fee: \$25.00

Requirements:

a. One complete work from any period of music

Portland District Instrumental: Includes piano and instruments. Open to statewide students grades 9 through 12. Standardized transcriptions and concertos will be accepted for instrumentalists but not for piano. (15 minutes allowed for this audition.) Entry fee: \$25.00
